These are from the seed orchards at the Meadowview Research Farm. They should be well adapted to Kentucky climate zones.

Become part of our science team by helping us evaluate the blight resistance of these latest trees. Your feedback on seedling performance will be critical in helping TACF researchers improve resistance. KY-TACF also welcomes donations of these Restoration chestnut seeds for special chapter projects and will assist in site selection and planting.
